Please remember that during these stormy times we have had our feet planted on solid rock and we are not given more than we can handle. We continue to stand in faith as we are **LOWELL JOINT STRONG** and we will stand strong against the storms that come our way; you are the beacon/lighthouse of educational excellence; **THANK YOU!**Cliff-note versions of a multifaceted/ever changing world:

LA County Public Health Department updated tracking numbers:

- Spread/case rate: Current data is 3.1/100K. Last week it was 3.1. (#/100K citizens- target is <7/100K).
 January 12th it was 77/100K.
- Test positivity percentage: Current data is 1.4%. Last week it was 1.5%. (target is <8%). January 12th it was 20.5%.
- o <u>Health Equity</u>: Current data is 1.9%. Last week it was 2.1%. January 12th it was 26.3%.

Orange County Public Health Department updated tracking numbers:

- Spread/case rate: Current data is 3.0/100K. Last week it was 2.8. (#/100K citizens- target is <7/100K). January 12th it was 78.8/100K.
- Test positivity percentage: Current data is 1.6%. Last week it was 1.7%. (target is <8%). January 12th it was 19.5%.
- Health Equity: Current data is 2.1%. Last week it was 2.6%. January 12th it was 24.2%.

More good news is that the numbers continue to drop significantly. As you are aware both LA County and Orange County have transitioned to the orange tier and are actually on track to transition to the yellow tier in the next couple of weeks—YA-HOO!

Our LJSD Safe Reopening Plans, *Return to School Adaptable Plan Continuum* and supporting documents are always on our website under <u>Healthy Families Updates</u> (<u>COVID19</u>). These are the links for the <u>California Department of Public Health</u> and the <u>Orange County Health Care Agency</u>. LJSD continues to have <u>very- very few</u> staff or students that have notified us that they tested positive; thank God. As a reminder all former and new <u>Safe Reopening Plans</u>, <u>CAL/OSHA order</u> and <u>Injury & Illness</u> Prevention Program (IIPP) have been completed and are posted on our webpage.

- Brief summary:
 - 1) Reopening has been awesome because of your patience and constant support.
 - 2) Thank you to everyone for all that you have done and continue to do; Ya'll are a Blessing!

- 3) I am sure you already know that we will have to give the annual CAASPP testing this spring, which is beyond silly. Please know that it is our/my position that we will simply ask our students to try their best, because we always try our best, yet there is absolutely no pressure. Our focus is on finishing this year strong socially-emotionally and preparing academically for the 2021/2022 school year. The 2022 Spring CAASPP test scores will be what we pay attention to and we have time to support our students as we fill any learning loss over the next year and a half.
- 4) Summer School 2021:
 - a. Dates: June 1st 24th, Monday-Thursday, from 8:30 am-11:30 (total of 15 days.)
 - b. Focus will <u>not</u> be computer screen time, but personal connection, engagement, and starting to fill learning gaps.
 - c. Hosted at Rancho (Grades 7-8) and at Meadow Green (Grades TK-6)
 - i. <u>Rancho: "Themed idea"</u>
 Focus areas such as, but not limited to: Writer Workshop activities by levels, outside activities, game based math activities, Read 180 curriculum (including ELL), Great

Works reading/writing project, STEAM/robotics activities, arts (could be dance, band, art, etc.), etc.

ii. Elementary: "Themed idea"

Focus areas such as, but not limited to: Writer Workshop activities by levels (primary and upper grade), Reading Plus, game based math activities, art (could be art, band, dance), STEAM/robotics activities, Great Works reading/writing project (ex. Hatchet), Engineering is Elementary, etc.

- d. An official letter and google sign-up form will come out at the end of next week so that families can sign-up if you are going to join us.
- 5) As we prepare for the 2021/2022 School Year, we will be sending out Virtual Academy Enrollment information to family's this coming Tuesday and there will be a zoom information meeting in the evening on April 19th. We will be operating Virtual Academy classes for those families who cannot and/or do not feel comfortable returning their students to in-person instruction next year. We will also send the survey to staff for those who wish to teach Virtual Academy classes.
- 6) We are keeping a close eye on the State colored tier levels as they continue to transition, which in turn will affect our social distance requirements.
- 7) Based on all of the data, and information coming from Public Health Departments, we are preparing to open the 2021/2022 school in our pre-pandemic format (normal), which means five days a week, full-time. We should all expect some form of ongoing safety measures, which we do not know as of yet (for example extra sanitation, handwashing, masks, etc.). All of that will become clear as we move through June and July.
- As we reopen campuses for in-person instruction, <u>PLEASE</u> remember to follow <u>all</u> of the safety protocols: social distancing, face coverings, wash hands, etc. Thank you for following these protocols; we have done a great job!
- The Measure LL Modernization/Construction work continues at a very fast pace and we are very pleased with the progress:
 - We are on track for Macy to move back to their home campus in June.
 - o Jordan will move to the Maybrook (temporary campus) in June and remain there for the 2021/2022 school year and move back in June of 2022.
 - o Meadow Green is scheduled to move to the Maybrook campus in June 2022.
 - o The following campuses are on track to be painted this summer: El Portal, Olita, and Macy. The remaining campuses will be painted as their modernization/construction work is completed.
 - The following campuses are on track to have their new digital marques installed this summer: El Portal, Olita, Macy, Meadow Green, and Rancho. Jordan will have theirs installed along with their construction work in 2021/2022.
 - Final details are being completed for the installation of a new playground for each campus this summer and possibly into the fall.
 - The Board of Trustees is completing the process of reviewing and approving a Master Facility Plan that will be our road map into the next 25+ years.


