We will continue to remind you that we are all **SO** proud of your heart, compassion, care, hard work, and being you. We know that you are feeling overwhelmed, but please remember to breathe while you give each other and yourself grace. We continue to stand in faith as we are **LOWELL JOINT STRONG** and we will stand strong against the storms that come our way.

We continue to monitor Los Angeles County Public Health orders and work to be able to re-open our schools for in-person instruction while providing the safest learning environment possible. As we continue to prepare for the time when we are able to return to in-person hybrid instruction, we want to circle back to affirm/re-affirm those families who anticipate needing to remain off campus due to an underlying health condition and/or confidential circumstances. As we seek to provide our students with our best instruction, we have been working behind the scenes to design our instructional program to provide the least disruption and smoothest transition possible. We have been able to make a fairly significant adjustment, which is that those students who need to remain in a 100% virtual learning setting will not have to change teachers or schools. We are excited to share that our incredible instructional staff has developed a structure that will allow 100% Virtual At-Home students to continue to zoom into class each day to receive their core instruction. This will allow our Virtual At-Home students to keep their same teachers. It is anticipated that once Los Angeles County Public Health Department allows in-person/hybrid instruction to restart, it will be required that we only have approximately 50% of our students on campus at a time in order to provide the necessary social distancing needed. In order to accomplish this, students will be divided into three cohorts/groups:

- Cohort A: attends in-person/on-campus instruction on Monday & Thursday and virtually from home Tuesday & Friday. Wednesday everyone will be virtual from home.
- Cohort B: attends in-person/on-campus instruction on Tuesday & Friday and virtually from home Monday & Thursday. Wednesday everyone will be virtual from home.
- Cohort C: Lowell Joint School District At-Home are those students whom are unable to attend inperson/on-campus and will participate in class 100% virtually each day for their instruction. (This will be for the remainder of the 2020/2021 school year).

Families <u>do not</u> need to submit a doctor's note, but we do need you to affirm/re-affirm your need to have your student complete their 2020/2021 schooling 100% virtually through the Lowell Joint At-Home option. <u>The deadline to affirm/re-affirm your need is by the close of business on Friday, November 6, 2020. Please note that this does <u>not</u> mean we are returning to inperson hybrid right away, but are simply working to make sure we have all of our plans in place and everyone knows what to expect; as much as possible in our ever changing world.</u>

The Strategic Planning Team continues to meet to help guide our next steps towards our return as we follow our Return to School Adaptable Plan Continuum and react to the Governor and Los Angeles County Public Health Department (LACPHD) Orders. We will continue to send out the Healthy Family Updates every two weeks to help the whole Lowell Joint Family stay updated.

All of these safety plans and power points will be posted on the school and district websites once they have been distributed to each school site's families.


Keeping the Lowell Joint Family Informed and Connected...
